Meeting was called to order by Chairman Tom Schilinski at 5:50 pm. Supervisor present Timothy J. Green. Also present, Secretary, Michele Kriznik, Secretary-Treasurer, Winford LaRue, Chief of Police, Michael Cruny, Solicitor and Veronica Mowry, Township Engineer.

Secretary's Report Tim Green:

*Minutes from regular township meeting March 15, 2021, Hearing March 30, 2021, Special meeting April 9, 2021 and Road Material bid meeting April 12, 2021. Tim motions to accept minutes as written. Tom seconds. Carried.

***Secretary-Treasurer's Report Michele Kriznik:**

*Revenues - \$109,002.41 Expenditures - \$106,296.38 Bank Balances – General Fund - \$80,624.36 Payroll - \$538.61. Tim motions to accept Treasurer's report and pay all bills except for Green's Towing and Cassidy Signs. Tom seconds. Carried. Tim motions to be all Cassidy Sign bills. Tom seconds. Carried. Tom motions to pay Green Towing bills. Tim abstains. The motion failed. Tom motions to pay Greens Towing bills. Tim seconds. Motion carried.

Zoning Officer's report Bill Tohey:

*Issued 19 letters, 19 complaints, 3 dangerous structures, 2 postings on Route 18, 11 garbage complaints, 1 public nuisance, 1 high grass and 1 chicken issue.

*20 permits - 12 zoning, 1 swimming pool, 1 new barn, 1 room addition for garage, 4 sign, 2 razing, 1 logging, 1 new driveway.

*5 garbage citations most in Francis Mine area.

Police Report Chief LaRue:

*Monthly report 202 calls, 3 criminal arrest – 1 DUI's, 1 simple assault, 1 aggravated assault.

*13 traffic citations, 1 non-traffic citations – garbage.

*Quarterly report 512 calls, 8 criminal arrests, 30 medical, 6 dui test, 17 traffic citations, 6 non traffic citations. 13 reportable accident, 8 non reportable accidents. Officers had 17 magistrate hearings, 1 Common pleas court hearing.

Supervisors report Tom Schilinski:

*Subdivision – Rommes (Simpson Road) Planning Commission accepted the subdivision. Tim motions to accept Rommes subdivision. Tom seconds. Motion carried.

*Subdivision – Brown (Behind Hubbard Road, Stravaggi Property) Planning Commission accepted the subdivision. Tim motions to accept Brown subdivision. Tom seconds. Motion carried.

*Resolution No. 2021-5R, Tax Collector's Bond. Anticipated tax duplicate is \$307,452.51. Tax Collector's Bond is set at 30% - \$92,235.75.

Engineers report Veronica Mowry:

*February 19, 2021 Range Resources reentry drilling. Richard Moore. 4 more wells. Minor grading. Enlarging storm water facilities. Issuing grading permit. Will probably start construction in June.

*Follow up – requirements to consolidate lots. MPC State regulations. If the number of lots change – either increase or decrease, have to do subdivision. If lot lines are the same number and don't change, you can do a simpler version.

Solicitors report Michael Cruny: Ordinance #2021-1. Rezoning of property Morgan Land Company. Village Residential district to Business district. Tim motions to adopt Ordinance #2021-1. Tom seconds. Motion carried.
