### **Secretary's Report Marie Ferguson:**

\*Minutes from Regular Township Meeting December 20, 2021. RC motions to accept minutes as written. Tim seconds. Carried.

### **\*Secretary-Treasurer's Report Michele Kriznik:**

\*Revenues - \$75,911.58 Expenditures - \$30,162.35 Bank Balances – General Fund - \$38,971.69 Payroll - \$865.32. Marie motions to accept Treasurer's report and pay all bills except for Green's Towing and Cassidy Signs. Tim seconds. Carried. Marie motions to pay Cassidy Signs bills. Tim seconds. RC abstains. \*Small Flow Sewage Treatment Facility Agreement – Brandon Riggle at 1349 Smith Township State Road. It's an installation and maintenance agreement for small flow treatment facility. Sewage Council denied. DEP is in charge. We will hold \$2,000. In escrow. Their sand mound

won't perk. (Smith Township has to make sure they do maintenance and get copy of receipts every year. Also, Escrow has to be kept at \$2,000.) Sewage Enforcement Officer has to check it. They tried to sell property but couldn't pass. Tim motioned to ok small flow treatment facility. Marie seconds. Motion carried.

\*Act 14 – Langeloth Metallurgical Company. Water quality management permit.
