Secretary's Report Marie Ferguson:

*Bids for paving project 2022. Morgan Excavating LP 15 Arenten Blvd. Upper Suite Charleroi PA 15022 was the only bid. 500 Ton 9.5mm - \$127.50 - \$63,750.00. 1,950 Ton 19mm - \$104.35 - \$203,482.50 Total - \$267,232.50.
