### **Secretary's Report Marie Ferguson:**

### **\*Secretary-Treasurer's Report Michele Kriznik:**

\*243 calls, 4 Criminal arrests – 2 Simple Assault, 1 DUI, 1 PFA Violation. 10 Traffic citations. Responded to 6 vehicle accidents.

\*18 Medical Assists, 3 Motor vehicle accidents, 1 Extrication of victim from building, 2 Fire alarms, 2 Power Lines down, 1 Smoke Detector.

\*Fire Chief, Brandon Kriznik reminded the board how important it is for all houses to have the house number on them So emergency vehicles can find the house quickly. We need to start enforcing the ordinance by citations. He also talked about Tom Krenn, the Full Time Firefighter has been checking the township for abandoned buildings. Already came up with over 50 of them so far. Can burn down some of these buildings for Fire Training. Chief also stated that the township needs to enforce weeds, garbage and junk vehicles. They would like to have Tom Krenn and Bill Tohey work together and/or split duties. Dan Petricca stated that there are no consequences for their actions. Michael Cruny stated based off of the guilty plea, the township would have the ability to abate whatever the violation is. They can fix the problem and lien the property. Also the ambulance service is a problem. Tom is a paramedic and they want to do ALS Where he can give medicine for pain and heart attacks. We also need a heart monitor.
